The Walker Township Supervisors met on Monday, January 4, 2010 for their annual organizational meeting as mandated by law. Harry Shearer, by motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner, was appointed as temporary chairman. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm. The Board organized in the following manner: Chairman – Harry Shearer, Vice Chairman – Martin Dreibelbis, Secretary/Treasurer – Nancy Baillie, Road Masters – All Supervisors, Township Solicitor – Randall Zimmerman, Engineering Firm – Bucharth Horn Inc., Zoning Hearing Board – Mervin Zendt (2013), Solid Waste/Recycling Coordinator – Steve Casner, Emergency Management Representative – Harry Shearer, Planning Commission – Ray Dysinger (2015) and Vacancy Board – Shirley Saner. This was done by motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried. By motion of Mr. Shearer, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to adjourn at 7:05 pm.

The Walker Township Supervisors met on Monday, January 4, 2010 at the Walker Township Municipal Building for their monthly meeting. Harry Shearer called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. Supervisors Casner and Dreibelbis were also present. The minutes of the December 7, 2009 meeting were read by the Secretary and approved by motion of Mr. Shearer, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried.

Visitors present: Mr. and Mrs. Steve Davis, Becky Leiter, Keith Leonhard, Jim Leiter (Mifflintown Hose Co.)

Mr. and Mrs. Davis were present to ask about remodeling the pet shop into an apartment to rent. The Supervisors have no information at this time. Mifflintown Hose Co dropped off their 2009 Financials and 2010 proposed budget and their fire contract. Mr. Dreibelbis questioned them on their information.

PERMITS: None

DAVIS UPDATE: None

OLD BUSINESS: The new private lane signs are being erected. At this time the Supervisors are not ready to order any more signs. Mr. Laird recommended “Short St” for the back alley in Mexico. The name was required by the 911 center.

PARK UPDATE: Mr. Dreibelbis reported construction on the building continues. Blocks were delivered. The weather has delayed any further progress on the building.

NEW BUSINESS: By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Shearer and carried it was resolved to approve the Page SEO, Inc. contract (2010-1) making them the sewage enforcement officers for Walker Township and setting the fees for sewage enforcement. By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to approve the Bucharth Horn Inc. contract (2010-2) making them the engineering firm for Walker Township and setting their fees for 2010.

By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried it was resolved to set the following wages for 2010: Lawn Mowing (Township Bldg) \$20, Park mowing \$10 per hour, Secretary/Treasurer \$11,220 per year, Zoning Hearing Board Members \$40 per meeting, Laborers \$13 per hour, Operators \$15 per hour, Planning Commissioners \$30 per meeting, Zoning/Building Permit Officer \$375 per month plus \$5 per permit. Charges for permits are as follows: Building/Zoning permits \$65, Driveway permits \$25 and Land Use permits \$45. Meeting dates will be the first Monday of the month except September, which will be on the first Tuesday. Depositories will remain at the Juniata Valley Bank.

Insurance reimbursements for “out-of-pocket” plans will be \$545.00 per month by motion of Mr. Shearer, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried.

SUBDIVISIONS: None

BILLS: By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Shearer and carried it was resolved to approve the monthly bills with checks 9848 through 9876 and 578 from Mexico Street Light fund. An EFT of \$1,126.95 was approved for payroll taxes.

February 1, 2010

The Walker Township Supervisors met on Monday, February 1, 2010 at the Walker Township Municipal Building for their monthly meeting. Harry Shearer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Supervisors Casner and Dreibelbis were also present. The minutes of the January 4, 2010 meeting were read by the Secretary and approved by motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried with the following corrections: Mifflintown Hose Co member Tom Leiter (not Jim) was present and the Secretary/Treasurer salary is \$11,460 not \$11,220.

Visitors present: Mr. Brett Lynch and Gloria Stuck (CJEMS). Mr. Lynch was present to get information on Act 1500. Act 1500, if passed by the state legislature, will impose a fee on townships that depend solely on State Police for police coverage. The supervisors have called Senator Corman and Representative Harris concerning this Act. The Supervisors are against the act because it would cause a financial hardship on the township's budget. He, also, was concerned about horse manure on the roadways. This matter has been researched and even if an ordinance were enacted it would not be enforceable.

Mrs. Stuck was present to give the Supervisors an update on Central Juniata EMS (CJEMS). She went over the number of calls in the Township and told them about their new service for bariatric patients. Also, she updated them on the new facility located in Mifflin.

PERMITS: By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to approve the following permits as issued by Mrs. Saner: Gary Reynolds (Occupancy), Andy Landis (Driveway and Building Permits), Linda Bossert (Demolition), Empire Kosher (land use) and Robert Shelley (land use),

DAVIS UPDATE: Karen Hackman stated there is no provision for a garage to be turned into an apartment in the Single Family Residential Zone – It's not a permitted use, not a conditional use, there is no special exception use nor could a variance be legally granted. Mr. Dreibelbis contacted the Davis' on February 1, 2010.

OLD BUSINESS:

PARK UPDATE: The weather has delayed further progress on the building. Mr. Casner asked about handicap parking by field 3. The handicap spaces are marked and located in the parking lot. The park is handicapped accessible as required. Mr. Dreibelbis will mention the parking to the Rec Board.

March 1, 2010

The Walker Township Supervisors met on Monday, March 1, 2010 at the Walker Township Municipal Building for their monthly meeting. Harry Shearer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Supervisors Casner and Dreibelbis were also present. The minutes of the February 1, 2010 meeting were read by the Secretary and approved by motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried.

VISITORS: Steve Brackbill and John Shirk. Mr. Brackbill was present representing B&A Development Co. His company owns the Robert Wright property at 5830 William Penn Hwy, Mifflintown. He would like to change the zoning from Single Family Residential to Industrial Commercial. By motion of Mr. Shearer, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to have Mr. Dreibelbis contact Mr. Zimmerman (Solicitor) to start the process to change the zoning. Mr. Shirk, representing CJEMS, provided the Supervisors with the company's 2008 financial report.

OLD BUSINESS:

PARK UPDATE: The weather has delayed further progress on the building. Mr. Dreibelbis mentioned the parking to the Rec Board. The Rec Board has stated that the park was designed to meet all ADA regulations and handicap parking is available in the parking lot. The Rec Board developed and the Supervisors approved the "Walker Township Park and Rules Regulations" on May 4, 2009 which restricts vehicle traffic to the parking lot.

NEW BUSINESS: Bids for equipment rental and materials were discussed. The time, equipment and materials will stay the same. This year the bids will be accepted on a line-by-line basis. By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Shearer and carried it was resolved to approve the private sale of the Ray R. Mangle property at 1073 Texas Hollow Rd, Mifflintown (parcel 17-8-92). This property was offered at the Sept 2009 upset tax sale and again at the Jan 2010 judicial tax sale without any bids being received. It became eligible to be sold privately upon receipt of any offer that is accepted by all the taxing authorities

April 5, 2010

The Walker Township Supervisors met on Monday, April 5, 2010 at the Walker Township Municipal Building for their monthly meeting. Martin Dreibelbis called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Supervisor Casner was also present. Absent: Harry Shearer. The minutes of the March 1, 2010 meeting were read by the Secretary and approved.

VISITORS: Paul Baker, Jessica Hemond, Meri Richardson, Carrie Jacobs, Joey Kunkel, Chris and Sherry Notesta, Lisa Stong, Teresa Kepner, Sandy Renninger, Eaya Renninger, Robert Renninger, Tiffany Lehman, Jean Berry, Jill and Kurt Condo, Paul Ginder, Wendy Wert, Tara Lukens, Wayne Lukens, Wanda Page, Kyleen Burns, and Helen Casner. Mr. Baker was present representing the Recreation Board. All other visitors are parents or concerned persons of Mexico Little League. The following issues were discussed:

Port-a-pot: Mrs. Hemond brought forth the issue of her son having a medical condition and the necessity of having a port-a-pot closer to field 3. Also, a safety issue concerning the location of the existing port-a-pots was mentioned. This matter has not previously been brought before the Recreation Board. Mr. Dreibelbis explained the matter should be presented to the Rec Board as they are empowered by ordinance to conduct all business for township parks. Mr. Casner made a motion to add an additional port-a-pot near field 3. Being no second the motion died.

Handicap parking: The group asked about the decision the Rec Board made concerning handicap parking near field 3. Mr. Baker reported the safety concerns of driving on the walking trail. Little League announced that negotiations were initiated with neighboring landowner Sam Kint regarding a road on his property. LL also reported that bids had been obtained. These new developments have not yet been discussed with the Rec Board.

Scheduling: The group requested that no weekend tournaments be scheduled during their season, which ends June 15th. Again, the Rec Board does all scheduling. It was recommended Little League bring this matter to the next Rec Board meeting on April 14th.

PERMITS: By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried it was resolved to approve the following permits as issued by Mrs. Saner: Moses K Renno (land use), John Weiger (land use), Ethan Good II (land use), Brad Detra (land use) and Lawrence Metzler (land use).

DAVIS UPDATE: Mr. Dreibelbis contacted Karen Hackman concerning the lawsuit, however, she has not heard anything from the courts.

PARK UPDATE: Block walls are in place, bridge was ordered, fertilizer was applied, grass areas were rolled and aerated, drains were cleaned out, work on the infields of Fields 1 & 2 was accomplished and the Boy Scouts completed their seeding project.

NEW BUSINESS: By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to approve an application to join the Federal Surplus Program.

There would be no increase to township residents, as far as the Township tax is concerned. Mr. Casner is not in favor of this change. Also, Mr. McFarland's request for a property dedication to straighten out River Rd was discussed. Mr. Knepp will be contacted to get a cost estimate to build the piece of road Mr. McFarland wants to donate.
